ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 22-05

The Court having reviewed the most recent information on the number and spread of COVID-19 cases in the Forsyth County community, the Court deems it appropriate and necessary, for the safety of persons required to attend court and the employees of the Forsyth County State Court and related agencies in the criminal justice system, to amend the State Court of Forsyth County court calendar as follows:

- 1. The Traffic Arraignment Calendar scheduled for Friday, January 14, 2022, is canceled. Cases will be re-noticed by the Clerk's Office staff or Criminal Case Coordinators as provided in the Court's Criminal Case Flow Management Order.
- 2. All persons entering the Forsyth County Courthouse must follow all relevant and applicable CDC Guidelines for quarantining and/or isolation if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, testing positive for COVID-19 or if recently exposed to someone with COVID-19.
- 3. A copy of this Order along with the following information shall be prominently placed on the websites for the Clerk's Office (www.forsythclerk.com) and the Forsyth County Courts (www.forsythcourts.com):

"Defendants who wish to pay a "payable citation", check the status of their case or discuss their case should go online to the Office of Clerk of Court's website at www.forsythclerk.com and follow the links on the "How Do I?" menu to either "Pay Citation" or "Case Search. Defendants may also "chat" live with a Court Clerk by clicking on the "Chat Now" link."

The Forsyth County Court Administrator and the Clerk of Court are directed and encouraged to disseminate the information in this Order to the appropriate news and community information sharing outlets.
