
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 15- 13
(Amending Administrative Order 15-8)


By Administrative Order 15-8, the Superior and State Courts established procedures governing the broadcast and retention of courtroom audio and visual transmissions. It has subsequently been determined that to improve security surveillance in the courtrooms and the secured judicial parking area, modifications to these procedures are necessary.

Therefore, Administrative Order 15-8 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Court security officers stationed in the Courthouse Control Room, in the course of performing their official duties, may also have access to courtroom real-time audio transmissions. However, the recording and retention of any audio or visual data from the courtroom remains prohibited.
2. Digital recordings from the security surveillance cameras positioned in the secured judicial parking area may be recorded and retained for no more than seven days, after which the data must be deleted.
