RE: Overpaid fines and fees held by Georgia Probation Management

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 17- 8

WHEREAS, Georgia Probation Management is authorized under O.C.G.A. § 42-8-101 to provide probation services to the court including the collection of fines, costs, and fees;

AND WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the probationers to pay such fines, costs, and fees, and keep Georgia Probation management informed of their current addresses;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to the terms of the written contract entered into between the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners and Georgia Probation Management, with the consent of the Chief Judge, under the authority of O.C.G.A. § 42-8-101, that in any case where the probationer has overpaid fines, costs, or fees and the probationer cannot be contacted at his or her last known address, and after diligent effort to locate the probationer the whereabouts of the probationer remains unknown, or the probationer refuses to claim such overpaid fines, costs, or fees, that upon a period of two years from the date the probationer could have claimed such monies, Georgia Probation Management shall deposit such monies with the Forsyth County Commissioner's Office.
