## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20-

Pursuant to the Order of the Supreme Court of Georgia entered on March 14, 2020, declaring a Statewide Judicial Emergency in the State of Georgia through April 13, 2020, and the Amended Order Declaring Judicial Emergency entered by Chief Superior Court Judge Jeffrey S. Bagley on March 16, 2020, the State Court of Forsyth County hereby amends its court calendars for the affected period of the judicial emergency as follows:

- 1. Criminal jury trials (McClelland) scheduled for the weeks of March 16<sup>th</sup> and March 23<sup>rd</sup> are canceled;
- 2. Civil jury trials scheduled (Abernathy-Maddox) week of March 23<sup>rd</sup> are canceled;
- 3. All civil non-jury calendars are canceled;
- 4. All criminal non-jury calendars are canceled; except that Jail Calendars and Probation Hearing Calendars for defendants who are in custody will be held as scheduled;
- 5. C.A.R.E. Court and DUI Court staffing and status calendars will go forward as scheduled subject to further direction from the court and/or the Accountability Court Staff;
- 6. DUI Court Graduation scheduled for April 1, 2020 is postponed.
